- Lay-offs The district will not commit to no further staff cuts.
 - CHTU is asking the district for no lay-offs in the next two years.
- "Essential" Training The district wants more control over where and when we have to attend professional development outside of regular work hours.
 - CHTU wants to keep advanced training "voluntary and compensated."
- Class sizes The district wants to increase roster caps and this could easily lead to larger class sizes.
 - o CHTU wants small class sizes to help our students learn more effectively.
- Course Selection Teachers should stay in control of class selection within our departments.
 - o **CHTU** knows that the teachers are the ones who should make this choice.
- 0% The district wants us to take the hit for its lack of financial planning
 - CHTU members worked hard for the levy and work hard every day. We are worth more than this and believe the community's vote for the levy is proof of such.
- The Future Past CHTU members fought and won the things we take for granted today in our contract. We must stand-up today or future contracts will only get worse: less pay, more work, and less input in school-wide decisions.
